Here is a recipe that Zelda would like to share with you.

APRICOT DELIGHT

1 quart water
3 Tb. tapioca
1 cup sugar
¼ tsp. salt
1 (3 oz.) pkg. orange gelatin

1 cup boiling water
½ lb. dried apricots

Cook tapioca in 1 quart water until soft. Cook dried apricots until tender and liquefy in blender. Dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Combine all ingredients and pour into a mold or container and chill until set. If desired top with whipped cream and serve. Makes 6-8 servings.
